


Ordinance for Reserve Police Officers

WHEREAS, PURSUANT TO North Carolina General Statutes 160a-282(a) and (b), a Town may by ordinance provide for the organization of a reserve police department made up of volunteer members: and by enactment of an ordinance, may provide that while undergoing official training and while performing duties on behalf of the Town pursuant to orders or instructions of the chief of police of the Town, reserve law enforcement personnel shall be entitled to benefits under the North Carolina Workers Compensation Act and to any fringe benefits for which such a volunteer personnel qualify.

There is hereby established within the Town police department, as a division thereof, a reserve police division. The reserve police division shall be a volunteer organization, whose members shall serve without compensation, composed of as many members as may from time to time be determined by the chief of police and approved by the Mayor.
